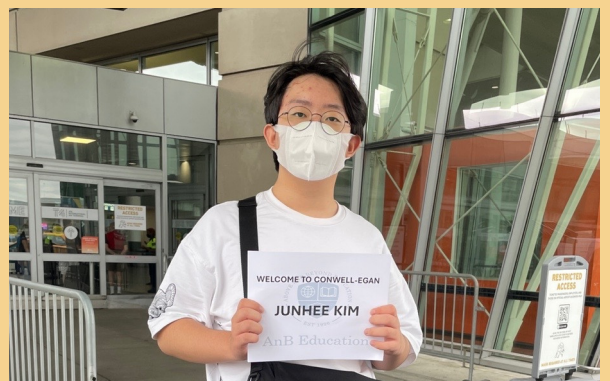


Welcome New Students!

College Tour

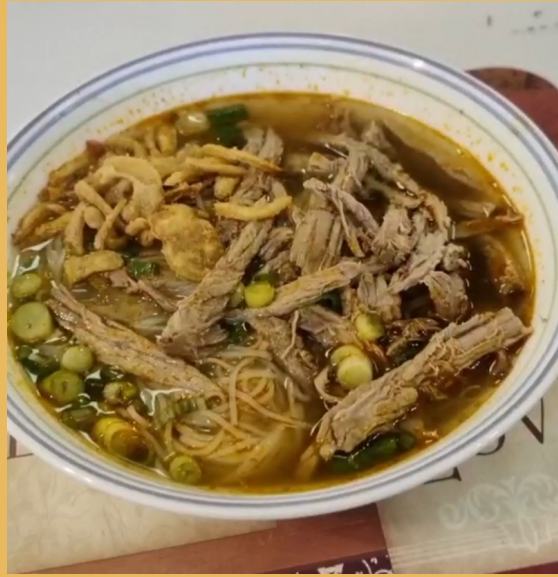

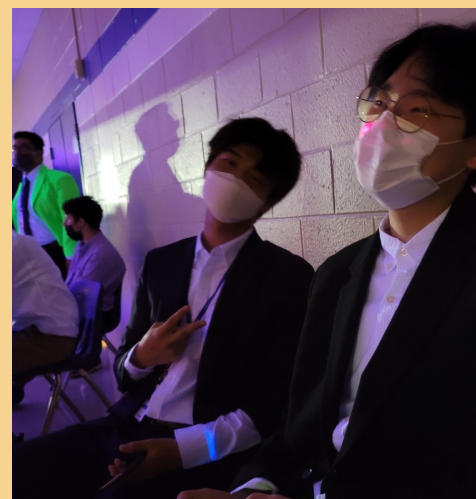
